Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliates we may share with can include mortgage companies, insurance companies, direct marketing companies and non profit organizations.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners may include credit card companies.
